## Using Glypho-Syn™ as an inert ingredient

What is Glypho-Syn™?

Glypho-Syn<sup>™</sup> is an EPA approved inert ingredient mixture approved for use in pesticide formulations. The agency has determined that Glypho-Syn<sup>™</sup> is approved for use in pesticide products with non-food use sites without restriction. It has also approved use in pesticide products used on food-use sites under 40 CFR 180.920, but please be advised that the tolerance exemption strictly limits its use. By law, the use limitations for tolerance exemptions must be followed.

What are the advantages of using Glypho-Syn™ as an inert replacement?
